To enter the program, a candidate must hold a Bachelor's from an accredited university. A transcript review is completed to determine which, if any, of the candidate's courses are equivalent to the professional education courses and the major/area courses required in our initial certification programs. The advising sheets for the initial programs are used to document the courses the candidate must complete to be eligible for certification. The candidate is not required to complete the university studies courses unless courses are required to complete a major or area. The candidate must meet all admission to Teacher Education (16 KAR 5:020), admission to Student Teaching (16 KAR 5:040) and exit requirements. These requirements are listed on the guide sheets. Please refer to each programs' submission for the guide sheets, assessments, alignments, and other needed information.
